


Minami Alps City **Community Bus Timetable**

Operates Daily (Except: Bus 1 on routes 1-4/6 and buses 1/2 on route 5 do not operate on Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays.) *Buses do not operate during year-end New Year holidays (December 29 through January 3).

Fare

100 yen (100 yen per transfer)	300 yen (Unlimited rides on all routes)	1,000 yen (For all routes: 11 tickets)	3,000 yen (For all routes for one year)	2,500 yen (For all routes for one year)

^{*}Up to two children under elementary school age per one accompanying adult may ride for free.

How to purchase

- 1. Pay the normal fare in cash or with an IC card when getting off the bus.
- One-day passes can be purchased on community buses.
- 3. Bulk discount tickets can be purchased on community buses as well as at the City Hall Main Office (Civic activities support division) or at other branch offices.
- 4. Commuter passes can be purchased in advance at the City Hall Main Office (Civic activities support division) or at other branch office service centers. Commuter passes are not sold on community buses.
- 5. Receipts cannot be issued for any sales made on community buses.
- 6. Refunds cannot be made for commuter passes or bulk discount tickets.

About commuter passes

- 1. Family members who currently live with the purchaser can use the same commuter pass.
- 2. Family members who currently live with the purchaser may share one pass to ride community buses together.
- 3. Please refrain from sharing a commuter pass with anyone other than family members who currently live with the purchaser.

How to ride the bus

1. Board the bus

When the bus approaches, raise your hand to make sure the driver has noticed you. Board the bus through the bus's back door.

2. Take a seat

If a seat is available, please sit down. If not, please stand while holding a hand strap or handrail.



3. Disembark

- Press a "stop" button when your stop is announced.
- In flexible-stop sections, inform the driver when you wish to disembark somewhere other than a bus stop.




4. Pay your fare (when disembarking)

- For cash, place the fare in cash (100 yen) in the fare box.
- For bulk discount tickets, place them in the collection box.
- For Transportation IC cards, touch the card on the card reader near the fare box.
- For one-day passes, show your one-day pass to the driver.

5. Arrival at destination

Exit through the front door.





About flexible-stop sections and alternate buses

- 1. Some community buses have flexible-stop sections, where you can board or disembark anywhere, as well as bus stop-only sections. (Please check the route map for details.)
- When boarding in a flexible-stop section somewhere besides a marked bus stop, please wait in a safe place where you will be visible to the bus driver. When the bus approaches, raise your hand in an obvious way to signal the driver to stop.
- 3. When disembarking somewhere other than a bus stop in a flexible-stop section, please tell the driver where you want to get off.
- 4. Due to safety concerns, it may not be possible to disembark in certain areas within a flexible-stop section.
- 5. On vehicle inspection days, alternate buses operated by Yamanashi Kotsu Co., Ltd. will run instead of the regular community buses.
- 6. The alternate buses used on vehicle inspection days are not wheelchair accessible. If you are using a wheelchair, please contact the Yamanashi Kotsu Co., Ltd. Shikishima sales office in advance. TEL 055-277-8911



^{*}The pass is valid from October 1 to September 30 of the following year. Regardless of when you buy the pass, the price does not change.

^{*}Discount commuter passes are available to those who buy five or more at the same time, or to those who have relinquished their driver's license and present their driving history certificate
